

Agency Funding Eligibility Criteria



All prospective applicants must meet Eligibility Requirements in order to apply for funding.

Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt health and human service organization with at least a two-year history of providing health and human service programs to the residents of Henderson County and have program results that clearly align with UWHC goals in the areas of Education, Income, Health, or Crisis Services/Basic Needs. Agencies may combine resources and apply together in a new collaborative program addressing one or more of the HC2025 Target Issues. Agency overhead expenses should be below 25% as calculated on most recent IRS Form 990.

Documents required ONE TIME (when agencies apply for the first time)

- 501 ©3 letter
- Mission Statement

Documents required EACH YEAR

- Annual Financial Audit
- IRS 990
- Agency Eligibility questionnaire
- Signature Page

Other items that agencies must be prepared to produce if requested

- Summary of Insurance Policies
- Certificate of Accreditation (if they are accredited by a state or national body)
- Financial Policies and Procedures
- Articles of Incorporation
- By-Laws
- Code of Ethics
- Non-discrimination Policy
