3,642 children

five and under received free, age-appropriate books mailed to their homes each month, enabling them to develop pre-literacy skills and a love of reading

1,169 youth

got support to overcome barriers through mentors and high quality after-school and summertime opportunities



213 residents

got the financial education and counseling they needed to avoid foreclosure, reduce debt, improve their credit and make smart choices about home ownership

175 residents

received free legal representation or advice to help them secure or protect their immigration status and/or legal work authorization



2,269 individuals

with low income and no health insurance benefitted from volunteer medical care, free or greatly reduced prescriptions, and health care case-management services

988 youth

engaged in after-school physical fitness and healthy nutrition and lifestyle programs in a fun, supportive setting



532 seniors
